WSET'S HONORARY PRESIDENT, Dr Laura Catena

Dr Laura Catena is WSET's Honorary President, a role we announced at our graduation ceremony last year. A former physician of Emergency Medicine for over 25 years in San Francisco and a fourth-generation Argentinian vintner, Laura is Managing Director of Catena Zapata, one of the oldest family wineries in Argentina, awarded 'World's Best Vineyard' in 2023.

Laura has been called "the face of Argentine wine" for her active role in studying and promoting the Mendoza wine region and Argentine Malbec. In 1995, she founded the Catena Institute of Wine, dedicated to preserving Malbec via industry-leading research and academic study.

Dr Catena has authored three books about wine: Vino Argentino, Gold in the Vineyards, and Malbec Mon Amour. She received the Meininger Outstanding Achievement Award 2023 and was named Old Vine Hero 2023 by the Old Vine Conference, as well as Drinks Business Woman of the Year 2022. An Executive Leadership Board Member at the University of California, Davis Department of Viticulture and Enology, she is also a board member of the Fulbright Commission in Argentina.

Sonal is India's first and, as yet, only Master of Wine; a coveted title she pursued straight after completing her WSET Level 4 Diploma in Wines and Spirits at WSET School London. For the past 17 years, she has been at the forefront of revolutionising wine culture in India. She pioneered wine education in the sub-continent, making this affordable and accessible for more people, through her namesake approved programme provider Sonal Holland Wine Academy.

Sonal consults international wine companies on how to enter and succeed in the Indian wine market through her work in consumer and trade research, marketing, communications and events. She founded India Wine Awards in 2017, an authoritative ranking of the best domestic and international wines available in the country. She is a wine consultant for her country's flag airline carrier, Air India, and also co-organises the Vinexpo Mumbai wine and spirits exhibition.

An award-winning broadcaster, Sonal has demonstrated her vast knowledge and thought leadership to garner over half a million loyal followers, making her among the most popular wine personalities in the world. Sonal remains hugely passionate about drawing global attention to her country's young and fast-developing market, ensuring that India has a voice in the global wine industry.
